The solo flute takes the orchestral harp part and therefore should be performed preferably as an “off-stage” solo. The rest of the choir are the string section, the melody evenly spread throughout. I recorded this on my second album, “When The Boat Comes In”.

As with all my arrangements, the lower parts may be substituted by clarinets & bass clarinets if the bigger flutes are not available.
